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




GDP Growth






GDP per capita






Economic Composition

Economic and Social Sector Achievements

- Inflation Rate: 1.35%,
- Exchange Rate is stable, LAK/USD depreciated 0.27%
- Foreign Reserves 6 months
- Import (first 3 quarters) declined 12.3%. Export increased 23.1%



Trade

- Total trade value 8,089 million USD:
 - Export value: 4,081 million USD increased by 10.29%
 - Import value: 4,008 million USD, 76% against the target.
 - Trade deficit: 73 million USD



Economic and Social Sector Achievements

- Poverty eradicated districts: 14 districts. Poor districts: 23 districts
- **Poor households:** 76,318 households, 6.56% of total households
- **Poor villages:** 1,689 villages
- **Drop-out rate at primary level** decreased from 5.2% to 4.9%.
- Underweight in children under 5: 25.5%
- Wasting in children under 5: 35.6%,
- Latrine usage 70.2% of total households
- Clean water usage 89.2% of population



Environmental Protection

- Implemented Decree No.15/PM
- Land titling: 50,405 plots, 84% against the target
- Land registration: 421,877 plots, 4 times exceed the target
- Forest restoration: 150,000 ha, 50% against the target
- Work on data analysis for mapping the areas prone to climate change risk and vulnerable areas: 90% against the target



Cross-Cutting Sector Achievements

- Developed Law on Anti- and Prevent Cyber Crime
- Expansion of optical fiber transmission line: 67,351 km, covering 18 provinces and 148 districts
- Localization of Mother and Child Strategic Plan: 3 provinces – Huaphanh, Saravan and Sekong
- Provision of capacity building to the members of LWU and unprivileged women
- Seek approval for 2 laws: Law on Local Administration, Law on Public Servants of Lao PDR



Pending issues

- Macroeconomic vulnerability
 - Budget: lacks liquidity in the state budget performance as a result of budget deficit and leakages.
 - High balance of payments deficit
 - Effective implementation on monetary and fiscal policies still face challenges.
 - Limited tools for money supply management



Pending issues (cont.)

- Expenditure management ineffectiveness and lack of focus resulting in debt outstanding; planning and financial disciplines is not yet well performed.
- Unfastened management on import-export and prices of goods resulting in inflated cost of living and prices of consumption commodities.
- Uncoordinated labor supply and demand caused underemployment




NSEDP Targets in the next 4 years

- GDP growth rate 7.2%:
 - Agriculture-Forestry: 3.4%, 16,8% of GDP by 2020
 - Industry: 9.3%, 39% of GDP by 2020
 - Services: 8.1%, 35.4% of GDP by 2020
 - Tax and import tariff, net: 5%, 8.8% of GDP by 2020
- GDP per capita 2,978 USD (GNI per capita 2,354 USD) by 2020
- Inflation rate fluctuated within the range of 5%
- Stability of exchange rate



Targets in the next 4 years: Total demand 173,329 billion LAK (21 billion USD), 29% of GDP

Main Targets

Rural Development and Poverty Eradication

- Poor household reduction: 5,580 households out of totally 76,318 poor households (2016)
- Poor villages: 178 village out of totally 1,689 poor villages (2016)

Education

- Survival rate at primary level to be reduced from 79.6% to 82%;
- Enrolment rate at early child education in children between 3-5 years: 51%, children under 5 years: 74%,
- Drop-out rate at the first grade and at primary level: 7% and 4% respectively
- Enrolment rate at lower and upper secondary level to increase from 82% to 85% and 47% to 51% respectively



Main Targets

Labor and Social Welfare

- Skilled development trainees: 131,600 people
- Expand of social protection coverage from 39% to 45% of total formal laborforce, 15% of total unit of operators/organizations
- UXO clearance: 4,500 ha. Provision of assistance to UXO victims: 300 people



Main Targets (cont.)

Health:

- Underweighting in children under 5: 22%
- Wasting in children under 5: 34%
- Mortality rate of children under 1: 43/1,000
- Mortality rate of children under 5: 56/1,000
- Maternal Mortality Rate: 182/100,000
- Provision of immunization vaccine 90%
- Clean water usage 87%



Environmental Protection

- To issue land titles to 85,000 plots and to register land on 100,000 plots
- Forest restoration in the national conservation and the national protected areas: 24 areas and 47 areas respectively



Implementing Policies and Measures

- 1. Improve macroeconomic management to ensure macro stability
- 2. Continue improving finance-budget management
- 3. Improve monetary management to ensure stability
- 4. Improve business environment
- 5. Promote production and services
- 6. Continue targeting on socio-cultural development and poverty reduction



Implementing Policies and Measures (cont.)

- 7. Localize and implement SDGs widely
- 8. Improve public administration and business operator management
- 9. National Assembly and Local Assembly to support the monitoring and evaluation activities
- 10. Create favorable environment for the development
