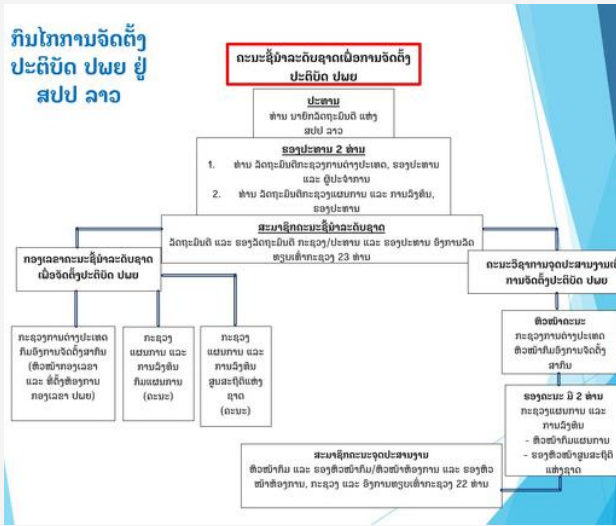

Adopted the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development



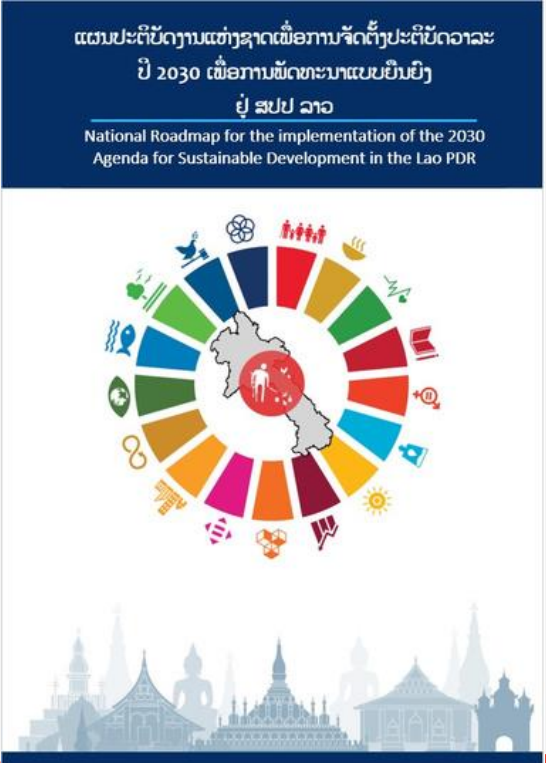
Adopted the National SDG Goal, identified policy and planning and the National SDG Implementation Mechanism

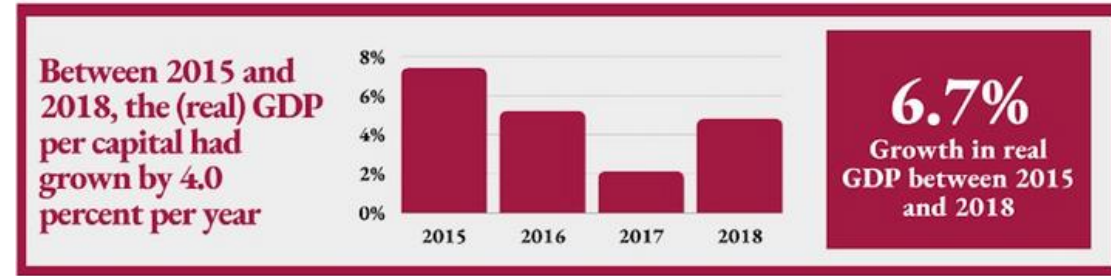
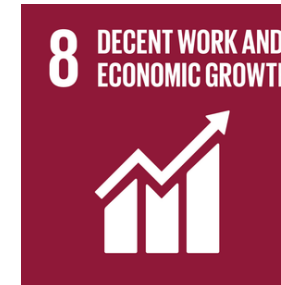


Three

The Disaster Recovery Framework (DRF) in line with Disaster Prevention and Control Law as well as Climate Change Decree

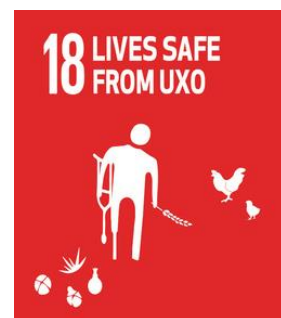
On September 7, 2016, Lao PDR ratified the Paris Agreement

18 LIVES SAFE FROM UXO

An estimated of 20,000 UXO accident survivors remain need assistances

The initial estimate of land contaminated by cluster munition is more than 2,873 villages

99% of high priority hazardous areas remaining to be cleared

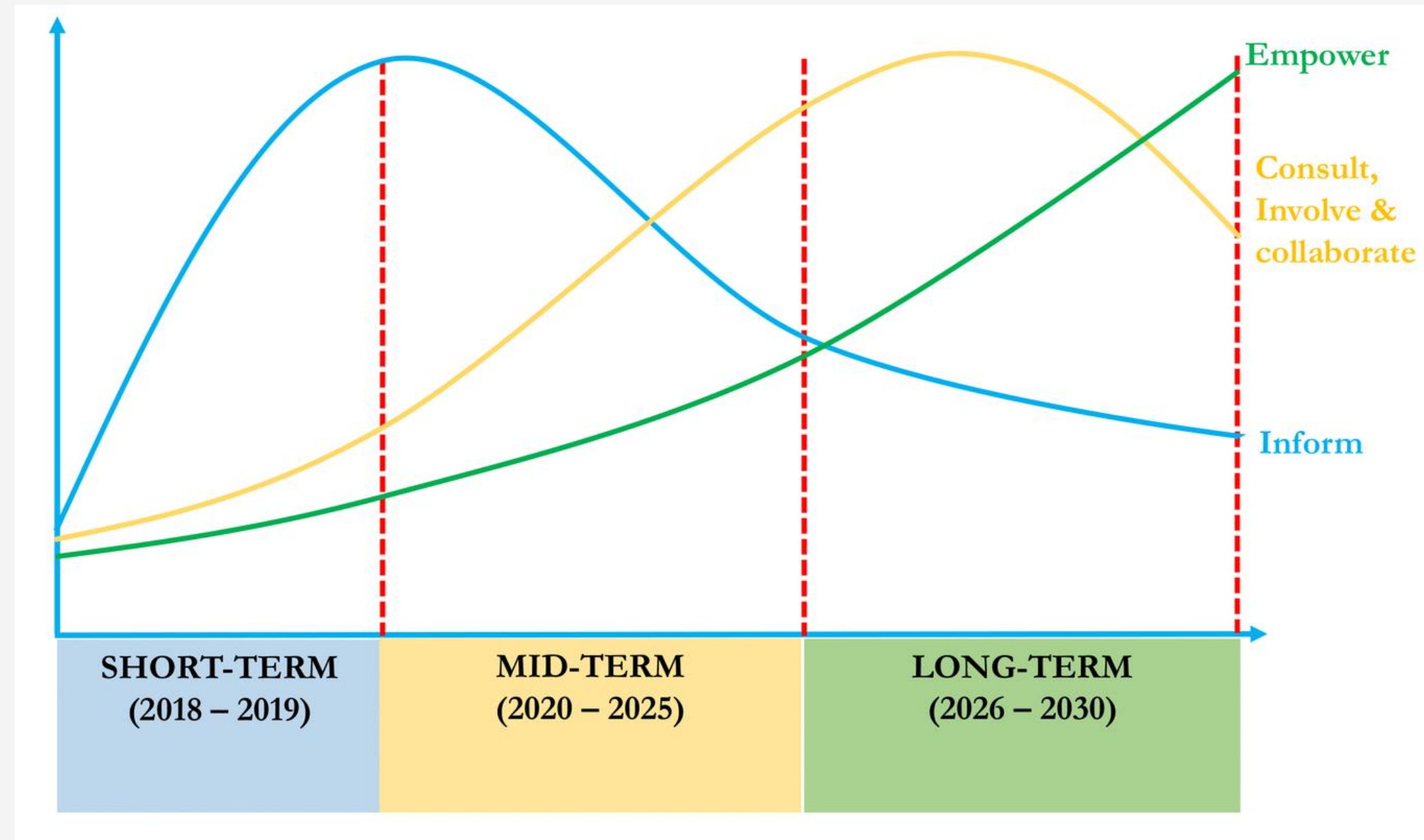
For recent years (from 2018 to February 2021), 116 UXO survivors received supports

CHALLENGES

- Greater efforts needed to ensure effective implementation and translation of the national development agenda (NSEDPP, SDG, LDC graduation, green growth, etc) into practical actions at national, sectoral and provincial levels
- Limited capacity (i.e Statistic and Data) and Infrastructure
- Awareness, Accessibility and Understanding remain limited
- Tight fiscal space, and limited resources & development financing options
- Impacted from COVID-19 and recovery efforts

Way Forward

1. Strengthening of links between 2030 Agenda, NSEDP, with focus on transition and graduation from LDC
2. Enhancing Horizontal and Vertical integration
3. Improving and strengthening Data and Statistic works as one of the top priority
4. Integrated Financing with the aim to yield effective, efficient and tangible outcomes
5. Strengthening Partnership and Cooperation in all levels, specifically private, CSO, NGO, International Organizations, youth, volunteers, academia, and public in general.
6. Accelerating the Advocacy and Awareness-raising efforts
7. Adapt to the New normal lifestyle



2022 key actions on SDG

1. Finalization of SDG metadata and SDG baselines
2. Setting SDG national benchmarks and targets for all SDG indicators
3. SDG awareness campaigns – at provincial, grass-root and general public levels
4. SDG open platform
5. Capacity building for h SDG focal points from line ministries on SDG implementation (SDGi) and SDG reporting (SDGr)
