



Final Decision on GA selection

Process

- On July 1, 2024, he presented the results of the committee's decision and the results of the approval of the Minister of Education and Sports at the ESSWG meeting, but the meeting could not approve the decision.
- Because on June 25, UNICEF wrote a letter to GPE to question the process and transparency of the committee's selection. (with documents)
- On August 7, 2024, GPE sent a notification letter, as well as explaining the process that the selection committee conducted according to the questions of from UNICEF and agreed to endorse the results of the decision according to the proposal of the committee and the results of the approval of the Minister of Education and Sports (with documents)

- After receiving the notification letter from GPE, on August 13th DoP made a report to the Minister regarding the results of GPE's decision to ask for guidance.
- On August 20, the Minister of Education and Sports sent a report on the decision to the Deputy Prime Minister, the Minister of Foreign Affairs and the Minister of Planning and Investment.
- On August 28, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs notified the Ministry of Education and Sports by giving the Ministry of Education and Sports in conjunction with the Ministry of Planning and Investment to further discuss and solve the problem.
- On September 2, the Department of Planning of MoES had a meeting together with the Department of International Cooperation of the Ministry of Planning to Investment to discuss the results of the decision based on the GPE's response letter and the contents of the report of the Minister of Education and Sports.

- On September 9, the Department of International Cooperation made a report to the Minister of Planning and Investment, stating the following content:
 - Through the consultation between the Department of International Cooperation, MPI, the Department of International Organizations, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Department of Planning of the Ministry of Education and Sports, it was found that if the process is prolonged, the grant may be lost, so it is appropriate to accept the selection results for UNICEF to manage the SCG fund worth 2.6 million dollars and the SCI to manage the STG fund worth 10 million dollars as certified by the Ministry of Education and Sports.
- On September 16, the Minister of the Ministry of Planning and Investment issued an official letter informing the Ministry of Education and Sports about the results of the decision, agreeing to approve it as certified by the Ministry of Education and Sports.
